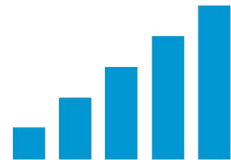
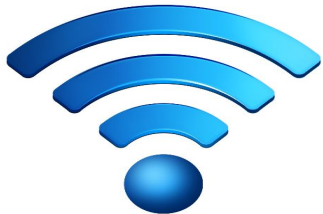

Secure Vs. Non Secure Browser

Browser security is the application of Internet security to web browsers in order to protect networked data and computer systems from breaches of privacy or malware.



Keeping your Laptop Safe

Expectations:

- ☐ All content including downloads, browser history, and hard drive can be reviewed at any time and contents must be entirely school related. I will use my device for school work ONLY.
